

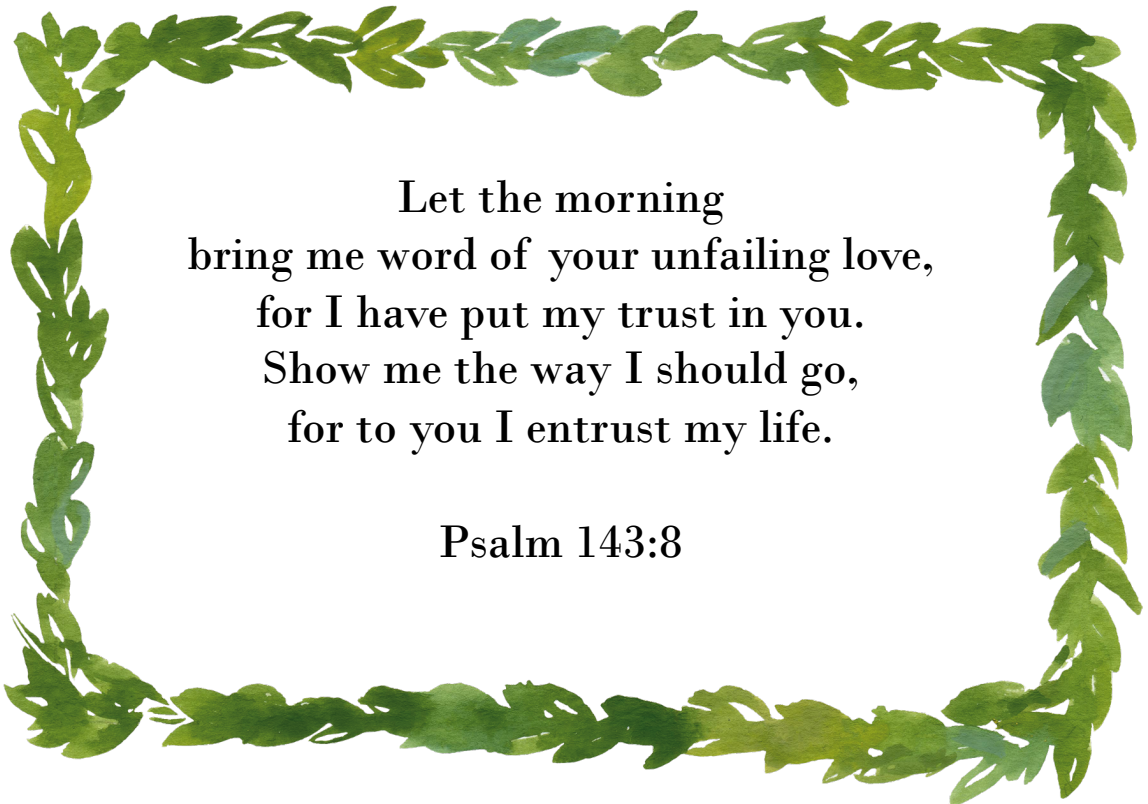
Morning Psalms *and* Prayers

Psalm 5:3




Let the morning
